Week 3	July 15-21 – PRAY FOR THE CHURCH AND THE LABOURERS "we constantly pray for you, that our God may count you worthy of His calling, and that by His power He may fulfill every good purpose of yours and every act prompted by your faith." 2 Thessalonians 1:11
Fri 15	In Sudan, two church leaders were arrested last June 14 <sup>th</sup> during a Bible study held at a center belonging to the Independent Baptist Church. They were accused of public nuisance offence and detained for four hours before being released on bail. Pray for an end to the harassment of Christian meetings.
Sat 16	A couple of workers asked for prayers that they would be able to travel soon to the Mekelle Youth Center in Ethiopia to help plan relief efforts. Praise the Lord for the faithful staff who have kept the center open during conflict. Pray that they would be able to continue the work and for the people there to have spiritual openness.
Sun 17	Last February 2018, a 17-year-old in Pakistan allegedly shared content on social media which some found to be blasphemous. He has been in custody since his arrest in 2018 without being given a trial. His lawyer attributes the delays to the involvement of an Islamic group that has called for the young Christian's death. Pray for him!
Mon 18	Pray for a couple who are at a point in their Arabic language training wherein they ask friends to share about their lives. The couple record their stories and listen to them until they can understand what was said. This will also give them the opportunity to build relationships with their neighbours. Pray for open doors!
Tue 19	People who live through diverse kinds of trauma have difficulty becoming ministers of hope. Pray for those who are caring and ministering to trauma survivors as they help people gain release from their suffering to become effective ministers of the gospel to others. Pray for the Holy Spirit's power, wisdom, and healing hand on them.
Wed-Thu 20-21	Many mission workers use businesses to bring God's light and love into hard and remote places. Pray for businesses still impacted by COVID while dealing with the reality of their location. However, we rejoice that God is moving mightily in the lives of the people impacted by these businesses!
Week 4	July 22-31 – PRAY FOR A MUSLIM REGION
	Nine rooms in the house of Islam: Eastern South Asia
Fri 22	In Bangladesh, recent flooding had washed away towns and train stations, killing dozens of people and displacing millions. At least 68 people had died since mid-May from flood-related causes, including drowning, electrocutions, and landslides. More than 4,000 people have been infected with waterborne diseases. Crops have been devastated. Pray for aid and for the 99% of Bangladeshis to hear and respond to the gospel!
Sat 23	Let us not forget about the Rohingya refugee crisis in Bangladesh. The refugee camps are getting worse, not better. There are reports of people coming to faith, but almost all of them keep it a secret. Pray for the safety of the Rohingya believers. They are so few in number and are in danger from the authorities in Myanmar who don't recognise them as citizens, and their fellow Rohingyas who see them as traitors for leaving Islam.
Sun 24	Headlining in India are the 10 Rohingya families that have converted to Christianity. Christian missionaries working on health and nutrition came to a Rohingya camp in India. J*, previously a Muslim, was enrolled in a Christian school and he later embraced Christianity. It was reported that about 1,500 Rohingyas living in Delhi, Haryana and Hyderabad have converted. Pray for the safety of the Rohingya believers in India.
Mon-Tue 25-26	The Ansari are a largely unreached Muslim group in North India, found mostly in the state of Bihar. Though they are considered unreached, with less than .1% Christian, the Lord is at work among them! There have been many families come to faith and recently more families have requested baptism. Pray that new believers will share boldly with their communities. Pray that multiplying movements will start among the Ansari.
Wed-Thu 27-28	Sri Lankan Moors are strongly shaped by Islam; hence most customs and practices are dictated by Islamic law. They have the complete Bible, as well as the Jesus film, Gospel recordings, the God's Story video, etc. Pray for workers to carry these resources to the Moors of Sri Lanka. Pray for movements to Christ among the Moors!
